CDP scores are widely used to drive investment and procurement decisions towards a net-zero carbon and resilient economy. CDP uses a detailed and independent methodology to assess these companies, allocating a score of A to D- based on the comprehensiveness of disclosure, awareness, and management of environmental risks and demonstration of best practices associated with environmental leadership, such as setting ambitious and meaningful targets.

Trivium earned a spot on the CDP's A List for the second year in a row, which indicates the company's dedication to high-quality data that provides a holistic view of the value chain's environmental impact. Leading in environmental transparency is one step towards more meaningful and effective action.

"Throughout 2024, we experienced unprecedented global temperatures, severe weather incidents, and significant impacts on nature, communities, and businesses.
